Q: I'm a member of the press. How do I arrange a visit?

Q: Do you allow movie crews to shoot at your facilities?

A: Each production request is considered on a case-by-case basis. There is a production fee to shoot stills or video/film for commercial projects. Please see our sample production agreement.

Q: I'm a student working on a photo project. Can I take pictures at your public attractions?

A: Students are allowed to take pictures from any of the public areas during normal operating hours as long as no public walkways are blocked.
