Dear Principals and Guidance Counselors:

Due to Legislative Acts #677 and #837, we can no longer request names or other student data. Instead, we ask that you submit **only the number of qualifying students for each award. We will ship blank membership certificates for you to personalize and distribute to students.**

Please email us at taylorawards@bellsouth.net with the correct number of BLANK certificates you will need for each award level to present to your students this year. Again, the qualifications are:

- Those in grades 7-12 earning a **2.5-2.9 GPA** during the 2019-20 school year are **TAYLOR STUDENTS** and will receive a one-year membership to Audubon Aquarium of the Americas, Audubon Butterfly Garden and Insectarium, and the New Orleans Museum of Art.
- Those in grades 7-12 earning a **3.0+ GPA** during the 2019-20 school year are **TAYLOR SCHOLARS** and will receive the same benefits as Taylor Students, plus a one-year membership to Audubon Zoo.

2. School name
3. School address (we cannot ship to post office boxes)
4. School city, state, and zip code
5. Number of BLANK certificates/membership cards needed for:
Students with 2.5-2.9 GPA
Students with 3.0+ GPA

Please respond by **April 13** to allow enough time for shipment of your **blank certificates and membership cards for your staff to personalize.**

Please let us know if you would like us to email you a NEW Microsoft Word template for the placement of the student information allowing you to print names directly on the certificates.

NOTE: MEMBERSHIP CARDS MUST HAVE THE STUDENT'S NAME AND SCHOOL ON THE CARDS IN ORDER TO BE ADMITTED TO ANY FACILITY.
